Keynote Speaker: Professor John W. Goodell



John W. Goodell is a Professor in the College of Business of The University of Akron. His research interests focus on the impact on financial systems of national culture, and institutions. In 2011 he received the Stockholm School of Economics/Women in the Academy of International Business Award for Increased Gender Awareness in International Business Research. His research has been highlighted in numerous media outlets including the Washington Post, PBS News Hour, and Bloomberg Businessweek, as well as the blogs of the Columbia University and Duke University law schools. He is formerly Assistant Editor of the Journal of Teaching in International Business, and formerly served on the Board of the Southwestern Finance Association. Since completing his PhD from Kent State University in 2008, he has co-authored over 115 articles and book chapters, including articles in the Journal of Banking and Finance, International Business Review, Energy Economics, and the Journal of Business Ethics. He is currently Editor-in-Chief of Elsevier's Research in International Business and Finance; as well as an Associate Editor for several leading finance journals. He is frequently invited to speak at international conferences and events.
